PARTNERSHIP METRICS

Last year, our 47 partner affiliates around the world created 1,141 new jobs and helped member businesses and farms retain 22,016 jobs that are supporting families and transforming lives. 160 North American mentors and 552 in-country mentors gave time and talents. Our network includes 8,000 business members in 20 countries.
