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How to Use This Toolkit

First, thank you. As a faithful supporter, your generosity helps build partnerships that create jobs and lift communities out of poverty. Your commitment makes a real difference.

Beyond your generosity, **your voice carries real influence.** As someone already invested in this mission, you have the unique opportunity to inspire others to get involved through volunteering, giving, or prayerfully following our work.

Inside this toolkit, you'll find simple, ready-to-use messages and resources that make it easier to share your passion for this mission with others—whether in conversations with friends, appeals at church, emails to your network, or posts on social media.

Use what fits your voice and context, adapt what you need, and feel free to make it your own. **Your word of recommendation is powerful** and can draw more people into this movement.

Boilerplate

A boilerplate is a short, standardized paragraph that describes our organization and work. You might use this in a church bulletin, as an introduction before an event, or anywhere you need a general description of our work.

Partners Worldwide (PW) is a faith-driven global network that strengthens communities through business. They partner with locally led organizations that serve entrepreneurs and connect them with business leaders who volunteer their skills to support business growth and job creation. These partnerships focus on practical support, shared learning, and long-term commitment that help expand opportunity in places facing high unemployment.

Since 1997, Partners Worldwide has worked across Africa, Asia, and the Americas to support local leaders and entrepreneurs building resilient and thriving communities.

Informal “We” Version

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Elevator Pitches

An elevator pitch is a short, clear, and compelling way to explain who you are, what you love about PW, and why it matters—in about 30–60 seconds, or the time it takes to ride an elevator. Think of it as your personal invitation to someone: “Here’s why I’m involved with Partners Worldwide—and why you might want to be too.”

Here are some scripts to get you started.

Elevator Pitch to Potential Volunteer

I love the work of Partners Worldwide. It’s a global, faith-driven network that fights poverty through business. They partner with local leaders to help entrepreneurs build redemptive businesses and create jobs.
